The qualifications for membership in NTHS are:

- **Attendance:** Attendance must be in accordance with Brewster Technical Center's Attendance Policy per program.
- **Program requirements:** All general program graduation requirements must also be met. **This includes passing all TABE requirements for program.**
- **Personal Characteristics:** The student demonstrates good character, leadership qualities, responsibility, and dependability. Student should also exhibit positive attitude and honesty.
- **Recommendation:** The student must be recommended by their program instructor and elected by a Brewster Technical Center administrator.
